

7/27/08 – 7/31/08 “All Hands On Deck Week”

Sunday – “Where is the Sun on Sun-day?” into rainstorm in the city drawing.

Monday – Give me a Hand – What does my right hand/left hand do? List inside the hand. Kids’ charades.

Tuesday - Give me a Hand – write inside hand trace one thing that your hand found/held that was beautiful – Mold w/ model magic into “hand stand”. Write in journal one thing that you “gave a hand with.”

Wednesday – Where does your rainbow end? Into messy play with foam and liquid watercolor – free themes.

Thursday – Paper Bag Players making puppets into messy play with slime and watercolor free theme expression. Paper Bag Players introduce themselves to Alice’s puppet Tom the Turtle.

8/3/08 – 8/7/08 – “What’s the Buzz? Is Anything Buggin’ Ya? Week” Insect theme ~

Sunday – Decorated plate at picnic with favorite picnic foods. Ice breaking games with names and foods that start with name initial, “build a story circle” with teddy bear.

Monday – “Flies, Flies Everywhere” – make fly puppets, and decorate tablecloth for picnic. Fly poem and story into “Is Anything Buggin’ Ya?” Wrote rap songs around bug theme, expressive dancing

Tuesday – “What’s the Buzz? Is your bee using its stinger or making honey?” – Art project drawing bee on a table honeycomb, and then throwing bee into hive.

Wednesday – “Ladybug, ladybug, Spider Web” Weave a web around the table – draw your ladybug or spider on the web! Talk about what the web feels like once your bug is caught in the web.

Thursday - “Just when the caterpillar thought the world was over, it became a butterfly” Create craft caterpillar into choice of craft kit butterfly or handprint butterfly. Talk about the concept of “metamorphosis – change.”

8/10/08 – 8/15/08 -- Beginning of Olympics Celebration – Nations of the World Theme

Sunday - Flags of the World – Present Flags -What is your favorite flag? If there were a flag that represented you, what would it look like? Draw/design it

Monday – “My Team” Who is on my Team? What is my Team named? What is our sport? Draw our team members, expressive symbol of sport, and name of team. Write about why depicted in this way, and gallery art “show-n-tell.” Explanation of Artist’s “interpretation.”

Tuesday – Program cancelled due to family emergency.

Wednesday – Olympic Flag Theme – Create your own circle from flag, representing your own Continent. Art Show-n-tell.

Thursday – Wicky sticks and other materials to make linking circles as in Olympic flag.. What do you have in common with each of the circles. Write what you have in common in your “niche.”

Sunday – How will you light the world? Make your own Olympic torch! Physical games – wiggle ball into hot potato and freeze into sports statue.
